Fully Funded Courses in Construction Multiskills

Applications welcome from adults (19+) who wish to take part in a taster course for a potential change of career with a nine-week course in Multiskills. The course covers a variety of building trades including making up flat pack units and fitting to walls; fixing skirting and architrave; bricklaying; and basic plumbing including sink units etc

To be considered for this course you must be willing to attend an awareness event and assessment day followed by a preliminary six-day training session (over two weeks). Successful students will then proceed through to the full nine-week course.

Throughout the duration of the course, local employers will be encouraged to visit the College and speak with candidates with a view to offering future employment or apprenticeships.

Students will learn useful hand tools and will receive a College Certificate of Completion. Places on the course are limited and will only be offered to those candidates who show good attendance, timekeeping, attitude, effort, progression and teamwork.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- be 19+
- live in the London Boroughs of Newham, Tower Hamlets, Hackney or Waltham Forest. Unfortunately we are unable to accept applications from anyone resident outside these areas
- demonstrate that they are unable to afford to pay for this course. We may ask for your bank statements and other documentation to prove this
- have written permission from their benefit adviser to do the course (if unemployed and claiming JSA or UC)
